> Identity and contact details of the controller

The entities of the Saint-Gobain Group, which offer a job to which you apply on the candidate portal, are the "data controllers" of the personal data. This processing is carried out in accordance with the applicable law.

Purpose of the processing activity

o Purposes

This processing activity has been set up to manage the recruitment of Saint-Gobain Group employees and, in particular, for the following detailed purposes:

- Creation of a platform allowing applications to be submitted in the context of the job offers of Saint-Gobain Group entities or information collected at a "job" or "student" forum, etc.;
- Selection of candidates: checking, recording and filing of CVs and cover letters in a database, management of the suitability of profiles for the position concerned (evaluation, etc.), etc.;

If you do provide such information, you agree that we may use it in accordance with applicable local laws or regulations and this Notice.
